Walker is a singer, song writer and actress who loves to sing jazz, standards, blues, country, contemporary and gospel music. In addition to being an

entertainer, she is a motivational speaker, and a community advocate and voice for veterans. Walker is also a U.S. Navy veteran, an eight-time recipient of the National Veterans Creative Arts Festival Award and an ambassador for Operation Rebound.

The concert will take place at 3 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 16, at the Brushwood Center at Ryerson Woods, 21850 N. Riverwoods Road, Riverwoods.
